I. Introduction

II. Paul, *Peter*, and Jude

A. Paul (Acts 17:30-31; 2 Thessalonians 1:6-9)

- Never once does Paul use the word *hell*
- “In the past” - Before the Gentiles were given the *proclamation* of the Gospel (Acts 17:30)
- “The man He has appointed” – specified in Daniels dream in Daniel 7:13-14 and seen in John 5:22 to be *Jesus Christ* (Acts 17:31).

1. The wrath of God is *retributive* and not corrective

- “They will be punished” vs. 9 – (diken tisousin), Lit. “They will *pay* a penalty”

2. Everyone not following Jesus will be *punished* (vs. 8)

B. Peter and Jude (2 Peter 2:2-9; Jude 6,7,4,13)

Peter’s description of hell and Jude’s description

- *Punishment* – (2 Peter 2:9; Jude 7)
- *Judgment* – (2 Peter 2:4; Jude 6)
- *Condemnation* – (2 Peter 2:3; Jude 4)
- *Suffering* – (2 Peter 2:13; Jude 7)
- Blackest *darkness* – (2 Peter 2:17; Jude 13)

C. Revelation

1. Revelation 14:9-11

- John is simply saying one thing - Don't **oppose** God!

2. Revelation 20:10-15
